([Ephesians 1:4,11](#))

- What does it mean to you that God specifically chose you to be his own?

[Ephesians 1](#) gives us some benefits to being chosen. Take a moment to read each benefit and the corresponding verses then talk about what each one means to you

1) The God I wish you knew chose us to be adopted into his family
([verse 5](#))

2) The God I wish you knew wants to lavish his forgiveness on us
(verse 7)

3) The God I wish you knew wants to empower you to succeed
(17-23)
