RESPONSIBILITIES ARE DETERMINED ON INTERNSHIP TYPE/SOME EXAMPLE TASKS INCLUDE

- Participate in worship band as needed
- Give messages when needed
- Attend camps
- Run a midweek
- Run a Sunday
- Plan and execute an event
- Lead Middle worship midweeks as needed
- Attend weekly staff meetings on Tuesday
- Meet with Youth Staff for planning meetings on Tuesday
- All interns will be required to read Doug Field's, "Your first two years in youth ministry."
- Oversee a student ministry (optional)

Compensation

To start a summer internship at Canyon Springs the intern must raise all necessary funds before starting. Youth Director will help walk the intern through the process of raising funds. All funds will remain in an internship account at Canyon Springs and intern will get paid as a staff member.

Youth Pastor and Intern will decide on the amount that will be raised based on need. Payment will be based on a bi-weekly payment schedule with all other staff members at Canyon Springs.

Most summer interns will raise 3,000 before starting internship (3 month summer). Intern can opt to raise less and make less.
