Romans 12:14-16

Harmony ~ The combination of simultaneously sounded musical notes to produce chords and chord progressions having a pleasing effect. Harmony is intentional, not accidental.

- When you are in harmony, it has a "pleasing effect." What does it take to be a harmonious person? Come this Sunday as we continue our Mastermind series looking at **Romans 12:14-16**, and we talk about ways to live a harmonious life the way Jesus did.
