- **Amos says in 6:1**

"Woe to those who are at ease in Zion, and to those who feel secure in the mountain of Samaria." **Verse 4:** "Woe to those who lie upon beds of ivory, and stretch themselves upon their couches." **Verse 6:** ". . . who drink wine in bowls and anoint themselves with the finest oils, but are not grieved over the ruin of Joseph."

- **Amos 3:15 the Lord says,**

I will strike the winter house along with the summer house, and the houses of ivory shall perish, and the great houses shall come to an end," declares the Lord.

- **Philippians 4:11-13**

I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. **12** I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty.
